CMV is the most common cause of congenital defects in babies in developed countries. Pregnant women who contract CMV can pass the virus onto their unborn baby, which can result in multiple disabilities. Congenital CMV causes more long-term problems and childhood deaths than Down Syndrome, Fetal Alcohol Syndrome, and neural tube defects.

Utah lawmakers led the nation by passing a bill that directs the Utah Department of Health (UDOH) to establish a public education program to raise awareness of CMV and ways to prevent its spread and to test newborns for CMV who fail their newborn hearing screening. Other states are following in Utah's footsteps.

The last international conference was held in 2012 so this conference is a must-attend for clinicians, researchers and public health experts. In addition, the conference will provide resources to increase awareness of CMV for University faculty, childcare providers, parents, students and non-profits. We anticipate between three and five hundred participants.
