### Conference Overview

The 2025 Congenital CMV Public Health and Policy Conference (cCMV-PHP) partners invite you to become a sponsor and/or exhibitor at this year’s event. CMV is the most common infectious cause of birth defects in babies in developed countries. Pregnant women who contract CMV can pass the virus onto their unborn baby, which can result in permanent disabilities. cCMV causes more long-term complications and childhood deaths than Down syndrome, Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders, and neural tube defects. It is the leading non-genetic cause of sensorineural hearing loss in infants.

The goal of the Congenital CMV conference is to present the latest research on screening, diagnosis and treatment, raise awareness, delineate prevention efforts, provide information about early intervention options, and disseminate family support resources in an effort to reduce the number of babies born with CMV and connect families affected by CMV with the resources they need to improve their quality of life.

We are thrilled to be hosting this conference in Minneapolis, Minnesota, the first state in the US to pass universal cCMV screening for infants. The conference will be held at the McNamara Alumni Center on the campus of The University of Minnesota. This conference is a must-attend for all stakeholders invested in the prevention, identification, and treatment of cCMV.
